



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **Sully , South Dakota [46119]**

Sully is one of 66 counties in South Dakota. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 1,400 ranked 64th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Sully had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$51,125. This PCPI ranked 1st in the state and was 166 percent of the state average, \$30,813, and 154 percent of the national average, \$33,123. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 14.2 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 5.6 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Sully was \$20,502 and ranked 13th in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 9.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Sully had a total personal income (TPI) of \$71,575\*. This TPI ranked 55th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Sully was \$32,393\* and ranked 59th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 11.8 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 8.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.3 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Sully. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 72.4 percent of TPI (compared with 62.8 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 20.0 percent (compared with 26.6 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 7.5 percent (compared with 10.6 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 14.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 3.1 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 9.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Sully increased from \$42,041\* in 2003 to \$48,485\* in 2004, an increase of 15.3 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 7.2 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$17,920\* to the 2004 estimate was 10.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
