



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Finney , Kansas [20055]**

Finney is one of 105 counties in Kansas. It is part of the Garden City, KS Micropolitan SA. Its 2005 population of 38,651 ranked 11th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Finney had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,731. This PCPI ranked 99th in the state and was 69 percent of the state average, \$32,709, and 65 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.7 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 5.5 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Finney was \$18,046 and ranked 59th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Finney had a total personal income (TPI) of \$878,586\*. This TPI ranked 17th in the state and accounted for 1.0 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Finney was \$657,953\* and ranked 11th in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 2.7 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 5.9 percent and the national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Finney. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 71.4 percent of TPI (compared with 74.6 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.2 percent (compared with 14.2 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.4 percent (compared with 11.2 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings remained unchanged; dividends, interest, and rent increased 14.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.5 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 2.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.3 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Finney decreased from \$731,890\* in 2004 to \$729,824\* in 2005, a decrease of 0.3 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 4.6 percent and the national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$571,101\* to the 2005 estimate was 2.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
