



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Edmonson , Kentucky [21061]**

Edmonson is one of 120 counties in Kentucky. It is part of the [Bowling Green, KY \(MSA\)](#). Its 2005 population of 11,930 ranked 89th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Edmonson had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$19,403. This PCPI ranked 99th in the state and was 68 percent of the state average, \$28,387, and 56 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.7 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Edmonson was \$12,635 and ranked 102nd in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Edmonson had a total personal income (TPI) of \$231,476\*. This TPI ranked 96th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Edmonson was \$136,683\* and ranked 104th in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 8.2 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 5.9 percent and the national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Edmonson. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 62.5 percent of TPI (compared with 60.8 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 10.2 percent (compared with 15.1 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 27.3 percent (compared with 24.1 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 14.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 15.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.7 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 5.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Edmonson increased from \$58,995\* in 2004 to \$64,542\* in 2005, an increase of 9.4 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 5.9 percent and the national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$41,257\* to the 2005 estimate was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
