



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood (MSA) [28660]**

Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2005 population of 354,629 ranked 136th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,734. This PCPI ranked 189th in the United States and was 86 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 11.0 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood was \$18,030 and ranked 311th in the United States. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood had a total personal income (TPI) of \$10,544,434\*. This TPI ranked 137th in the United States. In 1995 the TPI of Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood was \$5,647,261\* and ranked 154th in the United States. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 12.9 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 75.8 percent of TPI (compared with 74.1 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.1 percent (compared with 14.1 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 13.2 percent (compared with 11.8 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 13.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 12.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.7 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 6.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood increased from \$7,667,010\* in 2004 to \$8,697,465\* in 2005, an increase of 13.4 percent. The 2004-2005 national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$4,680,656\* to the 2005 estimate was 6.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.
