



BEARFACTS 1988 – 1998

Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area , Alaska [02232]

Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area[†] is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1998 population of 3,573 ranked 21st in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 1998 Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,721. This PCPI ranked 14th in the state and was 90 percent of the state average, \$27,560, and 92 percent of the national average, \$26,883. The 1998 PCPI reflected a decrease of 1.3 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 3.0 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 1998 Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area had a total personal income (TPI) of \$88,329*. This TPI ranked 20th in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. The 1998 TPI reflected a decrease of 4.9 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 7.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area. In 1998 net earnings accounted for 60.1 percent of TPI; dividends, interest, and rent were 22.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts were 17.4 percent. From 1997 to 1998 net earnings decreased 12.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.0 percent. From 1988 to 1998 net earnings cannot be calculated; the growth rate for dividends, interest, and rent cannot be calculated; the growth rate for personal current transfer receipts cannot be calculated.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area decreased from \$66,644* in 1997 to \$57,704* in 1998, a decrease of 13.4 percent. The 1997-1998 state change was 3.7 percent and the national change was 7.8 percent.
