



BEARFACTS 1988 – 1998

Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area , Alaska [02290]

Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1998 population of 6,618 ranked 16th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 1998 Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$17,263. This PCPI ranked 25th in the state and was 63 percent of the state average, \$27,560, and 64 percent of the national average, \$26,883. The 1998 PCPI reflected a decrease of 0.6 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 3.0 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1988 the PCPI of Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area was \$12,440 and ranked 23rd in the state. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.3 percent and for the nation was 4.5 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 1998 Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area had a total personal income (TPI) of \$114,247*. This TPI ranked 18th in the state and accounted for 0.7 percent of the state total. In 1988 the TPI of Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area was \$118,006* and ranked 14th in the state. The 1998 TPI reflected an increase of 0.3 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 7.4 percent. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 0.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area. In 1998 net earnings accounted for 48.8 percent of TPI (compared with 61.6 in 1988); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.0 percent (compared with 14.4 in 1988); and personal current transfer receipts were 36.2 percent (compared with 24.0 in 1988). From 1997 to 1998 net earnings decreased 1.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 3.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.9 percent. From 1988 to 1998 net earnings decreased on average 2.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.9 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area decreased from \$79,679* in 1997 to \$77,513* in 1998, a decrease of 2.7 percent. The 1997-1998 state change was 3.7 percent and the national change was 7.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1988 estimate of \$101,538* to the 1998 estimate was - 2.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.8 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
