



## **BEARFACTS 1988 – 1998**

### **Treutlen , Georgia [13283]**

Treutlen is one of 159 counties in Georgia. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1998 population of 6,635 ranked 145th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 Treutlen had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$14,509. This PCPI ranked 154th in the state and was 57 percent of the state average, \$25,279, and 54 percent of the national average, \$26,883. The 1998 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.3 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 6.2 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1988 the PCPI of Treutlen was \$9,219 and ranked 157th in the state. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.5 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 Treutlen had a total personal income (TPI) of \$96,266\*. This TPI ranked 148th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1988 the TPI of Treutlen was \$55,510\* and ranked 149th in the state. The 1998 TPI reflected an increase of 3.7 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 8.7 percent and the national change was 7.4 percent. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.2 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Treutlen. In 1998 net earnings accounted for 58.1 percent of TPI (compared with 62.1 in 1988); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.8 percent (compared with 15.8 in 1988); and personal current transfer receipts were 25.1 percent (compared with 22.1 in 1988). From 1997 to 1998 net earnings increased 3.5 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 0.3 percent. From 1988 to 1998 net earnings increased on average 5.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.0 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Treutlen increased from \$33,847\* in 1997 to \$34,679\* in 1998, an increase of 2.5 percent. The 1997-1998 state change was 9.2 percent and the national change was 7.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1988 estimate of \$24,259\* to the 1998 estimate was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.9 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
