



BEARFACTS 1988 – 1998 Edwards , Kansas [20047]

Edwards is one of 105 counties in Kansas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1998 population of 3,480 ranked 86th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 1998 Edwards had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$26,500. This PCPI ranked 10th in the state and was 104 percent of the state average, \$25,483, and 99 percent of the national average, \$26,883. The 1998 PCPI reflected an increase of 16.6 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 6.0 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1988 the PCPI of Edwards was \$18,728 and ranked 7th in the state. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 4.5 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 1998 Edwards had a total personal income (TPI) of \$92,219*. This TPI ranked 78th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1988 the TPI of Edwards was \$72,403* and ranked 77th in the state. The 1998 TPI reflected an increase of 14.1 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 7.4 percent. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Edwards. In 1998 net earnings accounted for 62.1 percent of TPI (compared with 62.9 in 1988); dividends, interest, and rent were 21.0 percent (compared with 23.0 in 1988); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.8 percent (compared with 14.1 in 1988). From 1997 to 1998 net earnings increased 23.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 1.4 percent. From 1988 to 1998 net earnings increased on average 2.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.3 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Edwards increased from \$47,428* in 1997 to \$58,156* in 1998, an increase of 22.6 percent. The 1997-1998 state change was 7.4 percent and the national change was 7.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1988 estimate of \$47,176* to the 1998 estimate was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
