



## **BEARFACTS 1988 – 1998**

### **Nye , Nevada [32023]**

Nye is one of 17 counties in Nevada. It is part of the Pahrump, NV Micropolitan SA. Its 1998 population of 30,487 ranked 7th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 Nye had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,928. This PCPI ranked 13th in the state and was 78 percent of the state average, \$28,260, and 82 percent of the national average, \$26,883. The 1998 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.1 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 5.2 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1988 the PCPI of Nye was \$15,771 and ranked 12th in the state. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 4.5 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 Nye had a total personal income (TPI) of \$668,534\*. This TPI ranked 7th in the state and accounted for 1.3 percent of the state total. In 1988 the TPI of Nye was \$243,456\* and ranked 8th in the state. The 1998 TPI reflected an increase of 10.4 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 10.5 percent and the national change was 7.4 percent. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of TPI was 10.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 10.4 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Nye. In 1998 net earnings accounted for 60.8 percent of TPI (compared with 74.0 in 1988); dividends, interest, and rent were 21.4 percent (compared with 15.6 in 1988); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.8 percent (compared with 10.4 in 1988). From 1997 to 1998 net earnings increased 9.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 12.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 11.3 percent. From 1988 to 1998 net earnings increased on average 8.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 14.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 16.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Nye increased from \$396,247\* in 1997 to \$422,588\* in 1998, an increase of 6.6 percent. The 1997-1998 state change was 10.1 percent and the national change was 7.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1988 estimate of \$422,713\* to the 1998 estimate was - 0.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 9.8 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
