



## **BEARFACTS 1988 – 1998**

### **LaMoure , North Dakota [38045]**

LaMoure is one of 53 counties in North Dakota. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1998 population of 4,794 ranked 27th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 LaMoure had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,205. This PCPI ranked 27th in the state and was 97 percent of the state average, \$22,872, and 83 percent of the national average, \$26,883. The 1998 PCPI reflected an increase of 24.3 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 10.6 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1988 the PCPI of LaMoure was \$8,032 and ranked 47th in the state. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 10.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.0 percent and for the nation was 4.5 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 LaMoure had a total personal income (TPI) of \$106,450\*. This TPI ranked 28th in the state and accounted for 0.7 percent of the state total. In 1988 the TPI of LaMoure was \$45,541\* and ranked 33rd in the state. The 1998 TPI reflected an increase of 21.8 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 10.2 percent and the national change was 7.4 percent. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of TPI was 8.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.9 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of LaMoure. In 1998 net earnings accounted for 56.6 percent of TPI (compared with 27.1 in 1988); dividends, interest, and rent were 25.4 percent (compared with 43.6 in 1988); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.0 percent (compared with 29.3 in 1988). From 1997 to 1998 net earnings increased 44.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 0.4 percent. From 1988 to 1998 net earnings increased on average 17.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in LaMoure increased from \$41,645\* in 1997 to \$59,892\* in 1998, an increase of 43.8 percent. The 1997-1998 state change was 12.0 percent and the national change was 7.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1988 estimate of \$14,006\* to the 1998 estimate was 15.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
