



## **BEARFACTS 1988 – 1998**

### **McIntosh , North Dakota [38051]**

McIntosh is one of 53 counties in North Dakota. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1998 population of 3,498 ranked 35th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 McIntosh had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,384. This PCPI ranked 29th in the state and was 93 percent of the state average, \$22,872, and 80 percent of the national average, \$26,883. The 1998 PCPI reflected an increase of 24.2 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 10.6 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1988 the PCPI of McIntosh was \$10,196 and ranked 32nd in the state. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 7.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.0 percent and for the nation was 4.5 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 McIntosh had a total personal income (TPI) of \$74,801\*. This TPI ranked 35th in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1988 the TPI of McIntosh was \$42,539\* and ranked 34th in the state. The 1998 TPI reflected an increase of 20.4 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 10.2 percent and the national change was 7.4 percent. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.9 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of McIntosh. In 1998 net earnings accounted for 45.5 percent of TPI (compared with 33.7 in 1988); dividends, interest, and rent were 28.5 percent (compared with 36.6 in 1988); and personal current transfer receipts were 26.0 percent (compared with 29.7 in 1988). From 1997 to 1998 net earnings increased 53.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 5.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 1.4 percent. From 1988 to 1998 net earnings increased on average 9.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in McIntosh increased from \$27,655\* in 1997 to \$39,894\* in 1998, an increase of 44.3 percent. The 1997-1998 state change was 12.0 percent and the national change was 7.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1988 estimate of \$17,774\* to the 1998 estimate was 8.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
