



BEARFACTS 1988 – 1998

Stutsman , North Dakota [38093]

Stutsman is one of 53 counties in North Dakota. It is part of the Jamestown, ND Micropolitan SA. Its 1998 population of 21,820 ranked 7th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 1998 Stutsman had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,891. This PCPI ranked 19th in the state and was 100 percent of the state average, \$22,872, and 85 percent of the national average, \$26,883. The 1998 PCPI reflected an increase of 14.5 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 10.6 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1988 the PCPI of Stutsman was \$12,654 and ranked 10th in the state. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 6.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.0 percent and for the nation was 4.5 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 1998 Stutsman had a total personal income (TPI) of \$499,473*. This TPI ranked 6th in the state and accounted for 3.4 percent of the state total. In 1988 the TPI of Stutsman was \$292,349* and ranked 5th in the state. The 1998 TPI reflected an increase of 14.6 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 10.2 percent and the national change was 7.4 percent. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.9 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Stutsman. In 1998 net earnings accounted for 61.6 percent of TPI (compared with 57.6 in 1988); dividends, interest, and rent were 21.4 percent (compared with 23.6 in 1988); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.0 percent (compared with 18.8 in 1988). From 1997 to 1998 net earnings increased 20.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 2.0 percent. From 1988 to 1998 net earnings increased on average 6.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.5 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Stutsman increased from \$306,582* in 1997 to \$360,542* in 1998, an increase of 17.6 percent. The 1997-1998 state change was 12.0 percent and the national change was 7.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1988 estimate of \$199,053* to the 1998 estimate was 6.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
