



## **BEARFACTS 1988 – 1998**

### **Greensville + Emporia , Virginia [51923]**

Greensville + Emporia is one of 105 counties in Virginia. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1998 population of 16,950 ranked 70th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 Greensville + Emporia had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$16,536. This PCPI ranked 97th in the state and was 60 percent of the state average, \$27,780, and 62 percent of the national average, \$26,883. The 1998 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.4 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 5.6 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1988 the PCPI of Greensville + Emporia was \$11,753 and ranked 94th in the state. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.1 percent and for the nation was 4.5 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 Greensville + Emporia had a total personal income (TPI) of \$280,280\*. This TPI ranked 81st in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1988 the TPI of Greensville + Emporia was \$170,755\* and ranked 78th in the state. The 1998 TPI reflected an increase of 4.9 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 6.7 percent and the national change was 7.4 percent. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Greensville + Emporia. In 1998 net earnings accounted for 61.1 percent of TPI (compared with 62.2 in 1988); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.1 percent (compared with 17.9 in 1988); and personal current transfer receipts were 22.8 percent (compared with 19.8 in 1988). From 1997 to 1998 net earnings increased 5.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 9.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.2 percent. From 1988 to 1998 net earnings increased on average 4.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Greensville + Emporia increased from \$241,608\* in 1997 to \$255,267\* in 1998, an increase of 5.7 percent. The 1997-1998 state change was 7.7 percent and the national change was 7.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1988 estimate of \$134,853\* to the 1998 estimate was 6.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.3 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
