



## **BEARFACTS 1988 – 1998**

### **Shawano , Wisconsin [55115]**

Shawano<sup>†</sup> is one of 72 counties in Wisconsin. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1998 population of 39,773 ranked 34th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 Shawano had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,028. This PCPI ranked 46th in the state and was 80 percent of the state average, \$26,175, and 78 percent of the national average, \$26,883. The 1998 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.8 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 6.8 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 Shawano had a total personal income (TPI) of \$836,361<sup>\*</sup>. This TPI ranked 36th in the state and accounted for 0.6 percent of the state total. The 1998 TPI reflected an increase of 7.9 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 state change was 7.4 percent and the national change was 7.4 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Shawano. In 1998 net earnings accounted for 66.2 percent of TPI; dividends, interest, and rent were 17.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts were 15.9 percent. From 1997 to 1998 net earnings increased 8.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.5 percent. From 1988 to 1998 net earnings cannot be calculated; the growth rate for dividends, interest, and rent cannot be calculated; the growth rate for personal current transfer receipts cannot be calculated.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Shawano increased from \$393,277<sup>\*</sup> in 1997 to \$427,980<sup>\*</sup> in 1998, an increase of 8.8 percent. The 1997-1998 state change was 7.3 percent and the national change was 7.8 percent.
