



## **BEARFACTS 1988 – 1998**

### **Wichita-Winfield (BEA-EA) [57179]**

Wichita-Winfield is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 1998 population of 1,045,925 ranked 66th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 Wichita-Winfield had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,291. This PCPI ranked 60th in the United States and was 90 percent of the national average, \$26,883. The 1998 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.6 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 national change was 6.1 percent. In 1988 the PCPI of Wichita-Winfield was \$16,162 and ranked 42nd in the United States. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.5 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1998 Wichita-Winfield had a total personal income (TPI) of \$25,406,972\*. This TPI ranked 65th in the United States. In 1988 the TPI of Wichita-Winfield was \$15,772,001\* and ranked 61st in the United States. The 1998 TPI reflected an increase of 5.7 percent from 1997. The 1997-1998 national change was 7.4 percent. The 1988-1998 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Wichita-Winfield. In 1998 net earnings accounted for 66.7 percent of TPI (compared with 67.7 in 1988); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.5 percent (compared with 19.9 in 1988); and personal current transfer receipts were 13.8 percent (compared with 12.4 in 1988). From 1997 to 1998 net earnings increased 6.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 7.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.3 percent. From 1988 to 1998 net earnings increased on average 4.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.0 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Wichita-Winfield increased from \$18,150,979\* in 1997 to \$19,225,741\* in 1998, an increase of 5.9 percent. The 1997-1998 national change was 7.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1988 estimate of \$12,095,444\* to the 1998 estimate was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.
