



BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999

Kodiak Island Borough , Alaska [02150]

Kodiak Island Borough is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is part of the Kodiak, AK Micropolitan SA. Its 1999 population of 13,760 ranked 8th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 1999 Kodiak Island Borough had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,264. This PCPI ranked 13th in the state and was 90 percent of the state average, \$28,100, and 90 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.6 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Kodiak Island Borough was \$23,617 and ranked 8th in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 0.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 2.7 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 1999 Kodiak Island Borough had a total personal income (TPI) of \$347,630*. This TPI ranked 7th in the state and accounted for 2.0 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of Kodiak Island Borough was \$309,358* and ranked 7th in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 3.0 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 2.8 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Kodiak Island Borough. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 67.5 percent of TPI (compared with 78.3 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.2 percent (compared with 13.5 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.3 percent (compared with 8.2 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 4.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 5.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.9 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings decreased on average 0.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.0 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Kodiak Island Borough increased from \$292,114* in 1998 to \$304,298* in 1999, an increase of 4.2 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 1.8 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$299,903* to the 1999 estimate was 0.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.1 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.
