



BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999

Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area , Alaska [02232]

Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area[†] is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1999 population of 3,453 ranked 21st in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 1999 Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,684. This PCPI ranked 12th in the state and was 91 percent of the state average, \$28,100, and 92 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.9 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 1999 Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area had a total personal income (TPI) of \$88,687*. This TPI ranked 21st in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 0.4 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 2.8 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 60.0 percent of TPI; dividends, interest, and rent were 21.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts were 19.0 percent. From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 0.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 6.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.4 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings cannot be calculated; the growth rate for dividends, interest, and rent cannot be calculated; the growth rate for personal current transfer receipts cannot be calculated.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area decreased from \$57,704* in 1998 to \$57,465* in 1999, a decrease of 0.4 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 1.8 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent.
