



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **San Miguel , Colorado [08113]**

San Miguel is one of 63 counties in Colorado. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1999 population of 6,396 ranked 43rd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 San Miguel had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$32,543. This PCPI ranked 9th in the state and was 107 percent of the state average, \$30,492, and 116 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.6 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 5.9 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of San Miguel was \$16,642 and ranked 20th in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 6.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 San Miguel had a total personal income (TPI) of \$208,147\*. This TPI ranked 39th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of San Miguel was \$56,699\* and ranked 49th in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 12.1 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 8.7 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 13.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.8 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of San Miguel. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 66.3 percent of TPI (compared with 64.5 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 30.0 percent (compared with 29.3 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 3.7 percent (compared with 6.1 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 11.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 13.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.1 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 14.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 14.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in San Miguel increased from \$155,976\* in 1998 to \$174,852\* in 1999, an increase of 12.1 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 10.9 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$42,209\* to the 1999 estimate was 15.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 8.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
