



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Fayetteville-Springdale-Rogers (MSA) [22220]**

Fayetteville-Springdale-Rogers is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 1999 population of 338,827 ranked 133rd in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Fayetteville-Springdale-Rogers had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,995. This PCPI ranked 284th in the United States and was 79 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.5 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Fayetteville-Springdale-Rogers was \$15,235 and ranked 249th in the United States. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Fayetteville-Springdale-Rogers had a total personal income (TPI) of \$7,452,660\*. This TPI ranked 148th in the United States. In 1989 the TPI of Fayetteville-Springdale-Rogers was \$3,573,278\* and ranked 165th in the United States. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 7.5 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Fayetteville-Springdale-Rogers. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 68.2 percent of TPI (compared with 64.8 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.9 percent (compared with 22.2 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.9 percent (compared with 12.9 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 10.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 0.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.6 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 8.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Fayetteville-Springdale-Rogers increased from \$5,424,403\* in 1998 to \$5,985,126\* in 1999, an increase of 10.3 percent. The 1998-1999 national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$2,704,392\* to the 1999 estimate was 8.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.
