



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Hinesville-Fort Stewart (MSA) [25980]**

Hinesville-Fort Stewart is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 1999 population of 72,095 ranked 361st in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Hinesville-Fort Stewart had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$15,585. This PCPI ranked 363rd in the United States and was 56 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.6 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Hinesville-Fort Stewart was \$9,551 and ranked 363rd in the United States. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Hinesville-Fort Stewart had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,123,626\*. This TPI ranked 365th in the United States. In 1989 the TPI of Hinesville-Fort Stewart was \$549,904\* and ranked 364th in the United States. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 7.2 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Hinesville-Fort Stewart. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 73.7 percent of TPI (compared with 77.1 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.9 percent (compared with 13.4 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.4 percent (compared with 9.4 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 8.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.1 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 6.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 7.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 10.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Hinesville-Fort Stewart increased from \$1,157,173\* in 1998 to \$1,179,902\* in 1999, an increase of 2.0 percent. The 1998-1999 national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$730,361\* to the 1999 estimate was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.
