



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Crow Wing , Minnesota [27035]**

Crow Wing is one of 87 counties in Minnesota. It is part of the Brainerd, MN Micropolitan SA. Its 1999 population of 54,173 ranked 16th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Crow Wing had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,377. This PCPI ranked 55th in the state and was 74 percent of the state average, \$30,106, and 80 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.5 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Crow Wing was \$14,849 and ranked 53rd in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Crow Wing had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,212,252\*. This TPI ranked 16th in the state and accounted for 0.8 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of Crow Wing was \$650,247\* and ranked 18th in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 4.4 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Crow Wing. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 59.2 percent of TPI (compared with 55.3 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 22.2 percent (compared with 24.3 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.6 percent (compared with 20.4 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 6.5 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 0.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.2 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 7.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Crow Wing increased from \$802,967\* in 1998 to \$856,081\* in 1999, an increase of 6.6 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$423,671\* to the 1999 estimate was 7.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.1 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.
