



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Banner , Nebraska [31007]**

Banner is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is part of the Scottsbluff, NE Micropolitan SA. Its 1999 population of 804 ranked 85th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Banner had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$18,562. This PCPI ranked 80th in the state and was 70 percent of the state average, \$26,465, and 66 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.6 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Banner was \$18,179 and ranked 11th in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 0.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Banner had a total personal income (TPI) of \$14,924\*. This TPI ranked 85th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of Banner was \$14,725\* and ranked 84th in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 3.9 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 0.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Banner. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 62.9 percent of TPI (compared with 73.5 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 23.6 percent (compared with 19.1 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 13.5 percent (compared with 7.3 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 6.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 0.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 1.2 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings decreased on average 1.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Banner increased from \$7,349\* in 1998 to \$7,710\* in 1999, an increase of 4.9 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$10,177\* to the 1999 estimate was - 2.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
