



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Stanton , Nebraska [31167]**

Stanton is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is part of the Norfolk, NE Micropolitan SA. Its 1999 population of 6,483 ranked 49th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Stanton had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,899. This PCPI ranked 63rd in the state and was 79 percent of the state average, \$26,465, and 75 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.9 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Stanton was \$14,874 and ranked 59th in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Stanton had a total personal income (TPI) of \$135,485\*. This TPI ranked 51st in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of Stanton was \$91,536\* and ranked 51st in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 2.0 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Stanton. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 75.8 percent of TPI (compared with 74.1 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 12.5 percent (compared with 17.5 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 11.7 percent (compared with 8.4 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 1.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 1.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 12.5 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 4.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Stanton decreased from \$85,423\* in 1998 to \$80,078\* in 1999, a decrease of 6.3 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$67,905\* to the 1999 estimate was 1.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.
