



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **McHenry , North Dakota [38049]**

McHenry is one of 53 counties in North Dakota. It is part of the Minot, ND Micropolitan SA. Its 1999 population of 6,066 ranked 21st in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 McHenry had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$17,183. This PCPI ranked 46th in the state and was 74 percent of the state average, \$23,180, and 62 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected a decrease of 10.3 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 1.3 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of McHenry was \$12,208 and ranked 39th in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 McHenry had a total personal income (TPI) of \$104,232\*. This TPI ranked 27th in the state and accounted for 0.7 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of McHenry was \$81,807\* and ranked 23rd in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected a decrease of 11.1 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 0.8 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of McHenry. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 50.0 percent of TPI (compared with 48.5 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 25.1 percent (compared with 28.6 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 24.9 percent (compared with 23.0 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings decreased 18.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 5.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 0.7 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 2.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.3 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in McHenry decreased from \$51,476\* in 1998 to \$38,200\* in 1999, a decrease of 25.8 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 1.4 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$38,313\* to the 1999 estimate was - 0.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
