



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Pueblo (MSA) [39380]**

Pueblo is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 1999 population of 140,184 ranked 260th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Pueblo had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,626. This PCPI ranked 303rd in the United States and was 77 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.8 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Pueblo was \$13,529 and ranked 338th in the United States. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Pueblo had a total personal income (TPI) of \$3,031,597\*. This TPI ranked 270th in the United States. In 1989 the TPI of Pueblo was \$1,672,653\* and ranked 287th in the United States. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 5.7 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Pueblo. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 58.5 percent of TPI (compared with 57.0 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.9 percent (compared with 20.9 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 24.6 percent (compared with 22.1 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 6.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 0.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.9 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 6.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.3 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Pueblo increased from \$1,805,757\* in 1998 to \$1,916,191\* in 1999, an increase of 6.1 percent. The 1998-1999 national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$1,066,081\* to the 1999 estimate was 6.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.
