



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Kleberg , Texas [48273]**

Kleberg is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the Kingsville, TX Micropolitan SA. Its 1999 population of 31,497 ranked 87th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Kleberg had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$17,346. This PCPI ranked 203rd in the state and was 66 percent of the state average, \$26,250, and 62 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.4 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Kleberg was \$11,099 and ranked 222nd in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Kleberg had a total personal income (TPI) of \$546,353\*. This TPI ranked 93rd in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of Kleberg was \$343,550\* and ranked 83rd in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 1.7 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Kleberg. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 65.5 percent of TPI (compared with 64.1 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.4 percent (compared with 18.9 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.1 percent (compared with 17.0 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 2.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 5.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.1 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 5.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Kleberg increased from \$361,224\* in 1998 to \$364,482\* in 1999, an increase of 0.9 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$246,873\* to the 1999 estimate was 4.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.
