



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Wichita-Winfield (BEA-EA) [57179]**

Wichita-Winfield is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 1999 population of 1,050,390 ranked 66th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Wichita-Winfield had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,504. This PCPI ranked 69th in the United States and was 88 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 0.9 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Wichita-Winfield was \$16,784 and ranked 54th in the United States. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Wichita-Winfield had a total personal income (TPI) of \$25,738,260\*. This TPI ranked 66th in the United States. In 1989 the TPI of Wichita-Winfield was \$16,470,239\* and ranked 62nd in the United States. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 1.3 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Wichita-Winfield. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 67.4 percent of TPI (compared with 66.7 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.5 percent (compared with 20.3 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.1 percent (compared with 13.0 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 2.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 3.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.6 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 4.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Wichita-Winfield increased from \$19,225,741\* in 1998 to \$19,616,550\* in 1999, an increase of 2.0 percent. The 1998-1999 national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$12,464,218\* to the 1999 estimate was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.
