



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Lake and Peninsula Borough , Alaska [02164]**

Lake and Peninsula Borough<sup>†</sup> is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 1,809 ranked 25th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Lake and Peninsula Borough had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,064. This PCPI ranked 23rd in the state and was 71 percent of the state average, \$29,870, and 71 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 12.7 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Lake and Peninsula Borough had a total personal income (TPI) of \$38,105\*. This TPI ranked 26th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 10.3 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.7 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Lake and Peninsula Borough. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 62.5 percent of TPI; dividends, interest, and rent were 12.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts were 24.6 percent. From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 10.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.6 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings cannot be calculated; the growth rate for dividends, interest, and rent cannot be calculated; the growth rate for personal current transfer receipts cannot be calculated.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Lake and Peninsula Borough increased from \$24,332\* in 1999 to \$27,047\* in 2000, an increase of 11.2 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent.
