



BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000

Wade Hampton Census Area , Alaska [02270]

Wade Hampton Census Area is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 7,042 ranked 14th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Wade Hampton Census Area had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$14,066. This PCPI ranked 27th in the state and was 47 percent of the state average, \$29,870, and 47 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 7.8 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Wade Hampton Census Area was \$10,436 and ranked 24th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 2.7 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Wade Hampton Census Area had a total personal income (TPI) of \$99,055*. This TPI ranked 21st in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Wade Hampton Census Area was \$60,696* and ranked 21st in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 9.5 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.7 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Wade Hampton Census Area. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 42.7 percent of TPI (compared with 56.8 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 7.6 percent (compared with 9.5 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 49.7 percent (compared with 33.7 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 3.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 1.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 16.9 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 2.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 9.2 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Wade Hampton Census Area increased from \$48,766* in 1999 to \$50,981* in 2000, an increase of 4.5 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$39,279* to the 2000 estimate was 2.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.0 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
