



BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000

Yakutat City and Borough , Alaska [02282]

Yakutat City and Borough[†] is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 802 ranked 27th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Yakutat City and Borough had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,091. This PCPI ranked 10th in the state and was 97 percent of the state average, \$29,870, and 97 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 17.6 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Yakutat City and Borough had a total personal income (TPI) of \$23,331*. This TPI ranked 27th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 11.9 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.7 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Yakutat City and Borough. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 56.5 percent of TPI; dividends, interest, and rent were 23.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts were 20.5 percent. From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 14.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.5 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings cannot be calculated; the growth rate for dividends, interest, and rent cannot be calculated; the growth rate for personal current transfer receipts cannot be calculated.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Yakutat City and Borough increased from \$15,010* in 1999 to \$15,684* in 2000, an increase of 4.5 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent.
