



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Crisp , Georgia [13081]**

Crisp is one of 159 counties in Georgia. It is part of the Cordele, GA Micropolitan SA. Its 2000 population of 21,973 ranked 75th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Crisp had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$19,669. This PCPI ranked 104th in the state and was 70 percent of the state average, \$27,990, and 66 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.5 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.2 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Crisp was \$13,156 and ranked 93rd in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Crisp had a total personal income (TPI) of \$432,178\*. This TPI ranked 80th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Crisp was \$263,404\* and ranked 68th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 2.8 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 8.6 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Crisp. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 58.7 percent of TPI (compared with 59.3 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.6 percent (compared with 18.4 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 23.7 percent (compared with 22.2 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings decreased 0.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.9 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 5.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Crisp decreased from \$290,179\* in 1999 to \$287,006\* in 2000, a decrease of 1.1 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 8.1 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$175,139\* to the 2000 estimate was 5.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.4 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
