



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Denver-Aurora-Broomfield (MSA) [19740]**

Denver-Aurora-Broomfield is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2000 population of 2,172,086 ranked 22nd in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Denver-Aurora-Broomfield had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$37,842. This PCPI ranked 12th in the United States and was 127 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.6 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Denver-Aurora-Broomfield was \$21,835 and ranked 31st in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Denver-Aurora-Broomfield had a total personal income (TPI) of \$82,196,255\*. This TPI ranked 20th in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Denver-Aurora-Broomfield was \$36,202,309\* and ranked 25th in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 13.3 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 8.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Denver-Aurora-Broomfield. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 76.7 percent of TPI (compared with 72.4 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.3 percent (compared with 19.2 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 7.0 percent (compared with 8.5 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 14.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 12.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.2 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 9.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Denver-Aurora-Broomfield increased from \$61,916,947\* in 1999 to \$70,027,353\* in 2000, an increase of 13.1 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$29,961,837\* to the 2000 estimate was 8.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
