



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Cuming , Nebraska [31039]**

Cuming is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 10,174 ranked 27th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Cuming had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,360. This PCPI ranked 4th in the state and was 103 percent of the state average, \$27,626, and 95 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected a decrease of 1.1 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.4 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Cuming was \$22,668 and ranked 3rd in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Cuming had a total personal income (TPI) of \$288,537\*. This TPI ranked 23rd in the state and accounted for 0.6 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Cuming was \$229,146\* and ranked 20th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected a decrease of 1.8 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Cuming. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 64.7 percent of TPI (compared with 72.0 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 21.9 percent (compared with 18.4 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 13.4 percent (compared with 9.6 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings decreased 6.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.9 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 1.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Cuming decreased from \$206,971\* in 1999 to \$193,093\* in 2000, a decrease of 6.7 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$176,632\* to the 2000 estimate was 0.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
