



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Dundy , Nebraska [31057]**

Dundy is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 2,292 ranked 75th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Dundy had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$26,970. This PCPI ranked 7th in the state and was 98 percent of the state average, \$27,626, and 90 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected a decrease of 6.8 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.4 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Dundy was \$20,619 and ranked 6th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Dundy had a total personal income (TPI) of \$61,815\*. This TPI ranked 70th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Dundy was \$53,260\* and ranked 71st in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected a decrease of 7.3 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Dundy. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 46.3 percent of TPI (compared with 59.6 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 35.7 percent (compared with 28.2 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.1 percent (compared with 12.2 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings decreased 17.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.7 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings decreased on average 1.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Dundy decreased from \$36,242\* in 1999 to \$29,818\* in 2000, a decrease of 17.7 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$35,007\* to the 2000 estimate was - 1.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
