



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Hayes , Nebraska [31085]**

Hayes is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 1,070 ranked 82nd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Hayes had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$16,870. This PCPI ranked 82nd in the state and was 61 percent of the state average, \$27,626, and 57 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected a decrease of 21.5 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.4 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Hayes was \$24,052 and ranked 1st in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was - 3.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Hayes had a total personal income (TPI) of \$18,051\*. This TPI ranked 83rd in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Hayes was \$29,344\* and ranked 81st in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected a decrease of 21.6 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Hayes. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 51.7 percent of TPI (compared with 79.8 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 30.2 percent (compared with 13.8 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.1 percent (compared with 6.4 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings decreased 37.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.5 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings decreased on average 8.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Hayes decreased from \$13,994\* in 1999 to \$8,724\* in 2000, a decrease of 37.7 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$21,371\* to the 2000 estimate was - 8.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
