



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Hitchcock , Nebraska [31087]**

Hitchcock is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 3,104 ranked 70th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Hitchcock had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$16,655. This PCPI ranked 84th in the state and was 60 percent of the state average, \$27,626, and 56 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected a decrease of 12.0 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.4 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Hitchcock was \$14,955 and ranked 72nd in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Hitchcock had a total personal income (TPI) of \$51,697\*. This TPI ranked 74th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Hitchcock was \$55,992\* and ranked 70th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected a decrease of 13.3 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 0.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Hitchcock. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 41.6 percent of TPI (compared with 56.9 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 31.2 percent (compared with 27.9 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 27.2 percent (compared with 15.2 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings decreased 28.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.9 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings decreased on average 3.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.1 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Hitchcock decreased from \$26,490\* in 1999 to \$17,824\* in 2000, a decrease of 32.7 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$29,482\* to the 2000 estimate was - 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
