



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Mount Vernon-Anacortes (MSA) [34580]**

Mount Vernon-Anacortes is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2000 population of 103,466 ranked 330th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Mount Vernon-Anacortes had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$27,288. This PCPI ranked 133rd in the United States and was 91 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.1 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Mount Vernon-Anacortes was \$17,797 and ranked 140th in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Mount Vernon-Anacortes had a total personal income (TPI) of \$2,823,390\*. This TPI ranked 293rd in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Mount Vernon-Anacortes was \$1,431,859\* and ranked 322nd in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 6.9 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Mount Vernon-Anacortes. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 60.3 percent of TPI (compared with 60.7 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 23.5 percent (compared with 24.2 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.2 percent (compared with 15.1 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 5.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 9.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.4 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 7.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Mount Vernon-Anacortes increased from \$1,740,698\* in 1999 to \$1,859,294\* in 2000, an increase of 6.8 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$948,115\* to the 2000 estimate was 7.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
