



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Jefferson , New York [36045]**

Jefferson is one of 62 counties in New York. It is part of the Watertown-Fort Drum, NY Micropolitan SA. Its 2000 population of 111,491 ranked 26th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Jefferson had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,884. This PCPI ranked 41st in the state and was 66 percent of the state average, \$34,898, and 77 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.2 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Jefferson was \$15,770 and ranked 40th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Jefferson had a total personal income (TPI) of \$2,551,344\*. This TPI ranked 28th in the state and accounted for 0.4 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Jefferson was \$1,759,109\* and ranked 27th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 5.6 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Jefferson. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 68.1 percent of TPI (compared with 70.6 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.7 percent (compared with 15.2 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.2 percent (compared with 14.2 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 5.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 6.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.7 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 3.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Jefferson increased from \$1,922,177\* in 1999 to \$2,019,320\* in 2000, an increase of 5.1 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$1,484,947\* to the 2000 estimate was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
