



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Steuben , New York [36101]**

Steuben is one of 62 counties in New York. It is part of the Corning, NY Micropolitan SA. Its 2000 population of 98,777 ranked 28th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Steuben had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,774. This PCPI ranked 13th in the state and was 82 percent of the state average, \$34,898, and 96 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 21.1 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Steuben was \$16,719 and ranked 30th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Steuben had a total personal income (TPI) of \$2,842,258\*. This TPI ranked 25th in the state and accounted for 0.4 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Steuben was \$1,659,957\* and ranked 28th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 21.5 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Steuben. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 70.2 percent of TPI (compared with 65.5 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.5 percent (compared with 18.1 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.3 percent (compared with 16.4 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 28.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.2 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 6.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Steuben increased from \$1,846,112\* in 1999 to \$2,477,693\* in 2000, an increase of 34.2 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$1,311,955\* to the 2000 estimate was 6.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
