



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Panama City-Lynn Haven-Panama City Beach (MSA) [37460]**

Panama City-Lynn Haven-Panama City Beach is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2000 population of 148,252 ranked 247th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Panama City-Lynn Haven-Panama City Beach had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,756. This PCPI ranked 260th in the United States and was 80 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.0 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Panama City-Lynn Haven-Panama City Beach was \$15,728 and ranked 268th in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Panama City-Lynn Haven-Panama City Beach had a total personal income (TPI) of \$3,521,822\*. This TPI ranked 250th in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Panama City-Lynn Haven-Panama City Beach was \$2,002,518\* and ranked 262nd in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 5.0 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Panama City-Lynn Haven-Panama City Beach. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 61.5 percent of TPI (compared with 65.6 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 21.1 percent (compared with 20.1 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.4 percent (compared with 14.3 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 2.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 9.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.0 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 5.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.9 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Panama City-Lynn Haven-Panama City Beach increased from \$2,425,041\* in 1999 to \$2,486,736\* in 2000, an increase of 2.5 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$1,485,187\* to the 2000 estimate was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
