



BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000

Alfalfa , Oklahoma [40003]

Alfalfa is one of 77 counties in Oklahoma. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 6,080 ranked 67th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Alfalfa had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,336. This PCPI ranked 38th in the state and was 83 percent of the state average, \$24,410, and 68 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 12.0 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 8.2 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Alfalfa was \$16,490 and ranked 10th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Alfalfa had a total personal income (TPI) of \$123,640*. This TPI ranked 68th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Alfalfa was \$105,274* and ranked 64th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 11.2 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 8.7 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Alfalfa. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 56.9 percent of TPI (compared with 59.7 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 23.8 percent (compared with 23.3 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 19.3 percent (compared with 17.0 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 14.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 12.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 2.3 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 1.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 2.9 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Alfalfa increased from \$62,007* in 1999 to \$70,145* in 2000, an increase of 13.1 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$70,289* to the 2000 estimate was - 0.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
