



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario (MSA) [40140]**

Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2000 population of 3,277,952 ranked 14th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,815. This PCPI ranked 298th in the United States and was 76 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.8 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario was \$17,839 and ranked 138th in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario had a total personal income (TPI) of \$74,787,087\*. This TPI ranked 21st in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario was \$46,926,284\* and ranked 19th in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 7.8 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 68.5 percent of TPI (compared with 70.6 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.0 percent (compared with 16.6 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.4 percent (compared with 12.8 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 7.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 9.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.4 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 4.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario increased from \$41,311,467\* in 1999 to \$44,692,882\* in 2000, an increase of 8.2 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$25,460,879\* to the 2000 estimate was 5.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
