



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Edmunds , South Dakota [46045]**

Edmunds is one of 66 counties in South Dakota. It is part of the Aberdeen, SD Micropolitan SA. Its 2000 population of 4,353 ranked 40th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Edmunds had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$27,888. This PCPI ranked 10th in the state and was 108 percent of the state average, \$25,723, and 93 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 8.3 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Edmunds was \$16,872 and ranked 17th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Edmunds had a total personal income (TPI) of \$121,398\*. This TPI ranked 34th in the state and accounted for 0.6 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Edmunds was \$73,309\* and ranked 38th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 8.0 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.6 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Edmunds. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 60.5 percent of TPI (compared with 55.8 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 25.0 percent (compared with 28.5 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.6 percent (compared with 15.7 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 8.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 9.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.3 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 6.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Edmunds increased from \$57,960\* in 1999 to \$62,703\* in 2000, an increase of 8.2 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.3 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$37,711\* to the 2000 estimate was 5.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.8 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
