



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Jasper , Texas [48241]**

Jasper is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 35,590 ranked 77th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Jasper had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,989. This PCPI ranked 135th in the state and was 74 percent of the state average, \$28,317, and 70 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.2 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Jasper was \$13,200 and ranked 181st in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Jasper had a total personal income (TPI) of \$747,001\*. This TPI ranked 75th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Jasper was \$410,203\* and ranked 79th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 7.0 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 9.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Jasper. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 60.3 percent of TPI (compared with 60.3 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.0 percent (compared with 18.3 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 22.7 percent (compared with 21.4 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 6.5 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 13.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.0 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 6.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Jasper increased from \$436,008\* in 1999 to \$442,378\* in 2000, an increase of 1.5 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 9.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$246,597\* to the 2000 estimate was 6.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.6 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
