



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **San Jacinto , Texas [48407]**

San Jacinto is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [Houston-Sugar Land-Baytown, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 2000 population of 22,452 ranked 107th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 San Jacinto had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$19,962. This PCPI ranked 163rd in the state and was 70 percent of the state average, \$28,317, and 67 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.9 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of San Jacinto was \$12,368 and ranked 210th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 San Jacinto had a total personal income (TPI) of \$448,184\*. This TPI ranked 112th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of San Jacinto was \$202,668\* and ranked 133rd in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 7.6 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 9.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 8.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of San Jacinto. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 66.0 percent of TPI (compared with 64.8 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.2 percent (compared with 15.9 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 19.8 percent (compared with 19.3 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 7.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 12.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.0 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 8.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 7.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in San Jacinto increased from \$85,286\* in 1999 to \$86,208\* in 2000, an increase of 1.1 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 9.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$45,710\* to the 2000 estimate was 6.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.6 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
