



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Daggett , Utah [49009]**

Daggett is one of 29 counties in Utah. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 928 ranked 29th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Daggett had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$15,218. This PCPI ranked 27th in the state and was 64 percent of the state average, \$23,866, and 51 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected a decrease of 4.4 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Daggett was \$13,371 and ranked 10th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Daggett had a total personal income (TPI) of \$14,122\*. This TPI ranked 29th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Daggett was \$9,346\* and ranked 29th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 1.2 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 8.5 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.6 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Daggett. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 55.2 percent of TPI (compared with 65.1 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 26.2 percent (compared with 21.8 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.6 percent (compared with 13.1 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings decreased 5.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 12.6 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 2.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.9 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Daggett decreased from \$14,714\* in 1999 to \$14,681\* in 2000, a decrease of 0.2 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$8,501\* to the 2000 estimate was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.9 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
