



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Monroe-Bastrop (BEA-EA) [57113]**

Monroe-Bastrop is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2000 population of 333,340 ranked 137th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Monroe-Bastrop had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,442. This PCPI ranked 172nd in the United States and was 68 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.7 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Monroe-Bastrop was \$13,083 and ranked 173rd in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Monroe-Bastrop had a total personal income (TPI) of \$6,813,980\*. This TPI ranked 142nd in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Monroe-Bastrop was \$4,277,031\* and ranked 143rd in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 4.6 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Monroe-Bastrop. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 61.9 percent of TPI (compared with 63.1 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.9 percent (compared with 17.2 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.1 percent (compared with 19.8 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 5.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 6.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.4 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 4.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Monroe-Bastrop increased from \$4,343,410\* in 1999 to \$4,557,118\* in 2000, an increase of 4.9 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$2,903,153\* to the 2000 estimate was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
