



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent (BEA-EA) [57125]**

Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2000 population of 624,943 ranked 96th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,112. This PCPI ranked 101st in the United States and was 81 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.4 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent was \$16,096 and ranked 100th in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent had a total personal income (TPI) of \$15,068,432\*. This TPI ranked 98th in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent was \$8,337,650\* and ranked 102nd in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 6.4 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 63.5 percent of TPI (compared with 67.4 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 21.3 percent (compared with 19.9 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.3 percent (compared with 12.7 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 6.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 6.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.6 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 5.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.0 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent increased from \$9,917,992\* in 1999 to \$10,496,395\* in 2000, an increase of 5.8 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$6,222,915\* to the 2000 estimate was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
