



BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001

Southeast Fairbanks Census Area , Alaska [02240]

Southeast Fairbanks Census Area is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 5,688 ranked 18th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2001 Southeast Fairbanks Census Area had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,408. This PCPI ranked 20th in the state and was 77 percent of the state average, \$31,666, and 80 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 7.3 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 6.0 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Southeast Fairbanks Census Area was \$17,481 and ranked 19th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.2 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2001 Southeast Fairbanks Census Area had a total personal income (TPI) of \$138,833*. This TPI ranked 15th in the state and accounted for 0.7 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Southeast Fairbanks Census Area was \$102,824* and ranked 16th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected a decrease of 1.0 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Southeast Fairbanks Census Area. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 57.8 percent of TPI (compared with 71.9 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.4 percent (compared with 13.2 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 25.8 percent (compared with 14.9 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings decreased 4.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.0 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 0.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.9 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Southeast Fairbanks Census Area decreased from \$83,289* in 2000 to \$74,676* in 2001, a decrease of 10.3 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 9.0 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$77,990* to the 2001 estimate was - 0.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.4 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
