



BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001

Yakutat City and Borough , Alaska [02282]

Yakutat City and Borough[†] is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 799 ranked 27th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2001 Yakutat City and Borough had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,516. This PCPI ranked 15th in the state and was 90 percent of the state average, \$31,666, and 93 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected a decrease of 2.0 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 6.0 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2001 Yakutat City and Borough had a total personal income (TPI) of \$22,784*. This TPI ranked 27th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. The 2001 TPI reflected a decrease of 2.3 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Yakutat City and Borough. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 59.2 percent of TPI; dividends, interest, and rent were 19.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts were 21.4 percent. From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 2.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 17.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 2.1 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings cannot be calculated; the growth rate for dividends, interest, and rent cannot be calculated; the growth rate for personal current transfer receipts cannot be calculated.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Yakutat City and Borough decreased from \$15,684* in 2000 to \$14,472* in 2001, a decrease of 7.7 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 9.0 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent.
